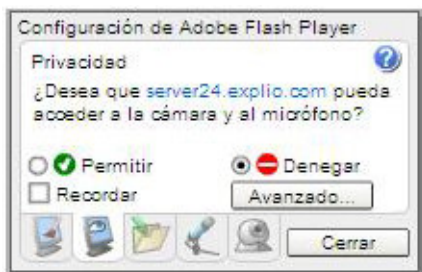


### Speaking activities. Definitions website.


Before starting you will need a working microphone connected to your computer and correctly configured to capture sound. This will depend on the make and model of your computer and sound card or sound module. You can check this here:

1. Go to: [www.definitions.mac-english.com/demo](http://www.definitions.mac-english.com/demo) .
2. Click on 'Demo'
3. Click on the 'Exercises' tab at the top
4. Click on '+' next to 'Speaking' on the left
5. Click on 'Asking about preferences 1'. You may see this dialogue



Choose 'Permitir' and 'Recordar' and then 'Cerrar'

6. To hear the 1st question, clic on :

Click here \_to listen to the first question

7. Listen and decide on your answer before recording. When you are ready to speak:



**REC** Click on the REC button to start recording.

Clic again to stop. You will receive one of the following responses

- I. Correct! (if your answer is correct)
- II. Sorry, wrong answer! Click on the REC button to try again. (if it is incorrect)
- III. Did not understand that.  
Click on the REC button to try again. (if badly-pronounced or not in the list of choices)

If (i) your answer is correct, you will hear new questions until reaching the end of the activity.

If your answer receives response (ii) or (iii), you can retry up to three times.

8. At the end of the activity, you will see the whole exchange with your answers marked in red or green, depending if they were correct or not.
