

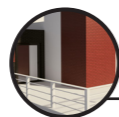

Sessions

Yvonne Dalorto Using phonics in the classroom

(3 to 7-year-olds)

Do you use phonics in your class or are you planning to? Find out what you can do after the children know their letters and sounds by introducing high frequency word games and fun phonic activities into your planning (whatever phonics system you use). In the session we will also learn about segmenting, blending and preparing children to read and write.

Emma Thomas Word walls: more than just writing on the wall

(8 to 12-year-olds)

A word wall is not just an excellent resource for developing literacy, it can also offer potential to enhance vocabulary learning and develop learner autonomy. However, the mere presence of a word wall in the classroom is not enough for learning to take place: it is what teachers and pupils do with it that is important. In this session a range of engaging activities to encourage pupils to interact with words walls will be demonstrated. We will use different types of word walls to fit with a range of different teaching contexts.

Elspeth Pollock Grammar - the 'old' and the 'new'!

12 practical presentation ideas for 6 grammar areas we often have to teach. Firstly a reminder of some of the 'old' but still successful ideas for presenting grammar, then the 'new' ways to do it using video clips, websites and IWBs.

(ESO)

This talk looks at the nature of games and learning. Starting from the historical perspective of how games were used to build and maintain empires we look at the components that make up a successful game and explore the benefits both social and linguistic of playing.
